Public reports indicate the sentencing in this case has been delayed until August.

I wanted you to be aware of the importance of this tuna cannery to the local economy as the largest private employer in American Samoa.

I support your enforcement efforts as well as all of the DOJ in seeking appropriate penalties and punishment.

However, please keep in mind the devastating effects that will occur in American Samoa should the cannery business go bankrupt and leave 2500 workers, 15% of the entire job base of 17,000, without jobs that sustain our community.
